**Guidance Counsellor:**

The School is entitled to an ex-quota Guidance Counsellor. This position has been successfully filled on a temporary year to year basis over the last 2 school years as the school's staffing did not permit the filling of the post until this year.

**Remedial Teacher:**

The School is entitled to an ex-quota Remedial/ Learning Support Teacher. This position has been successfully filled on a temporary year to year basis over the last 2 school years as the school's staffing did not permit the filling of the post until this year.

An important part of this post is the ability to teach Mathematics to Leaving Certificate ordinary level. Similarly the capacity to teach LCVP and Business is an advantage as many students with learning difficulties in this school choose these options.

**Home Economics Teacher:**

The School's 2 Home Economics Teachers retired one year ago and the School was allowed to fill only one post through Curricular Concessions. For the next school year the DES has granted no Curricular Concessions and the school is not entitled to make a permanent appointment. Hence the post will continue as a temporary RPT position for the 2010/11 School Year. We are required to re-advertise this position and to notify the Director of the Post Primary Redeployment Scheme of the vacancy

**Mathematics to LC Higher and Geography / English:**

This part-time temporary RPT position arises due to increased enrolment and a curricular deficit in these subject areas. A graduate majoring in pure Mathematics who has the

capacity to teach up to LC Higher is required for part-time hours. We also seek a teacher of English /Geography to LC Higher. This may be one position or two or more parts and the final distribution of hours will be determined by the qualifications of the successful candidate/s.

**Teacher of English as a Second Language:**

We have a small number of Newcomer Students who need skilled teaching of English as a Second Language. This part-time temporary RPT position is to meet specific needs of identified students for the next school year.
